This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the One Design rules for the class, and the sailing instructions.

The Cattail Regatta is open to all One-Design classes with a minimum of three boats per class. Catalina 22, Interlake, Mystere 4.3, Hobie Wave, Thistle, Snipe, Force 5, Lightning, Laser and Sailboard fleets are all welcome. A Portsmouth class is available for classes of less than three boats. **The Catalina 22 fleet will also be competing for the Bruce Sondys Memorial Trophy, awarded annually as part of the JRSC Cattail Regatta.**

This event will be sailed on a Windward/Leeward course, with start and finish in the center of the course. Length and number of times around the course will depend on wind conditions and performance capabilities of the Class. One race constitutes the Regatta. Three races will be the goal.

Awards presentation to immediately follow racing. Awards per fleet are dependent upon the number of entries in the class. Scoring will be on the Low Point System per the Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix A.

The Race Committee may use VHF radios to communicate with Interlake competitors on the water as allowed by Article III, Section 14 of the ISCA Specifications.

The cost for the event will be \$25 for boat registration.
