1 in 68 children in the United States have some form of Autism
This includes 1 in 42 boys and 1 in 189 girls.

- An estimated 50,000 teens with autism become adults and lose school-based autism services – each year.
- Around one third of people with autism remain nonverbal.
- · Around one third of people with autism have an intellectual disability.
- Certain medical and mental health issues frequently accompany autism. They include gastrointestinal (GI) disorders, seizures, sleep disturbances, attention deficit and hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), anxiety and phobias.

GOAL Autism School has 45 students currently ranging from Ages 5-28. They have an elementary classroom and they have a workplace for Independence program for anyone ages 16 and up. Most of their program is a 3-1 student to teacher ratio.

Motorcycle runs in the past five years has bought them things such as:

- 1. Two passenger vans
- 2. Additional Field Trips that the parents or autism scholarship does not cover such as Put-In-Bay, African Safari etc.... (some of these kids have never rode in a boat before)
- 3. Art supplies, Sensory re-enforcers, computers, printers

This is why Dave and I do the bike run and his name is Jason my son, a proud junior member of Cooley Canal Yacht Club and a student at GOAL Autism. He loves boating, motorcycles and anything that ends in vacation. The islands are his favorite place to be. Autism or not he's a smart kid lol!!!
