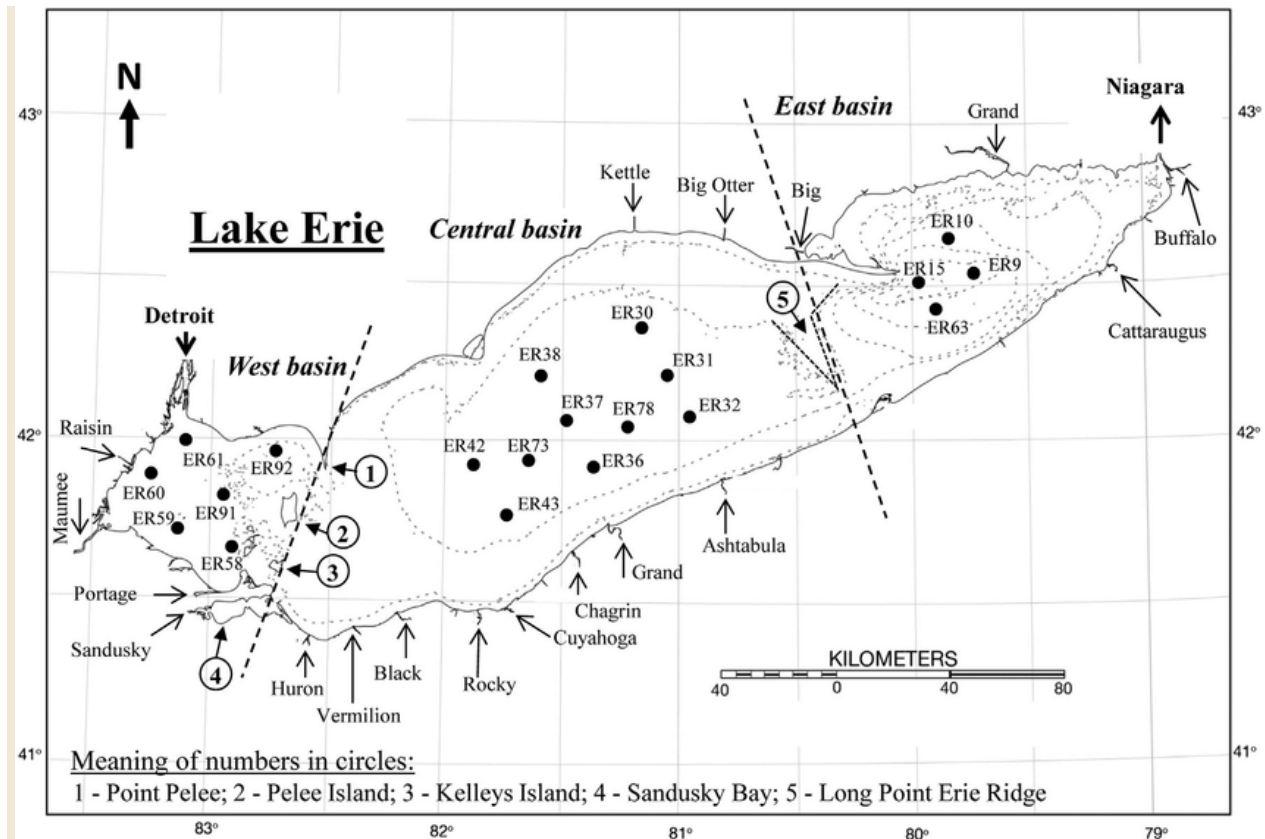

Lake Erie's Central Basin's water comes from Western Lake Erie/the Detroit River. The Central Lake Erie Basin is deeper - average 62' than the western basin (Average depth 24') Lake Erie 2019. The Central Basin public water intakes are challenged by 'dead zones.' Additionally the Cuyahoga River in the Central Basin is experiencing a come back from clean ups, dam removal and wastewater treatment. Other issues in the Central Basin include proposed wind turbines - the first in the Great Lakes, Asian Carp and challenges from waters flowing from western Lake Erie. There are currently assessment efforts to reintroduce the sturgeon to the Cuyahoga.

Water levels in the Great Lakes are rising creating many challenges and plastics continue to threaten waters world wide.
